About MigraACT

MIGRAACT – Youth Migrants in Action is a 24-month Capacity Building project funded by the Erasmus+ programme.

The project responds to one of today's most pressing challenges: supporting the personal and professional integration of young migrants in Europe and the South Mediterranean region.



The project strengthens youth workers' competences to better support the social and professional integration of young migrants. By combining Non-Formal Education, resilience-based approaches and employability tools, MIGRAACT promotes inclusion, mental well-being and equal opportunities across Europe and the South Mediterranean region.



What We Do

- **Transnational Cooperation**

We organise partner meetings, to actively support the project with collaboration.

- **International Training Course**

Each partner will send 10 youth workers to Sassari, Italy, for a 5-day training. Participants will explore migrants' needs, NFE methodologies, public speaking, and digital storytelling, and will collaboratively develop the first draft of the Toolkit for migrants.

- **Local Workshops & Piloting**

We implement workshops in each partner country to test tools and directly support young migrants in skills recognition, job preparation and mental well-being.

- **Multiplier events**

we hold awareness activities and public events to share results and ensure long-term impact.

Our Impact

Three main innovative educational outputs will be developed:

- 1 **Training Format**
- 2 **"Enhancing young migrants' skills" Manual**
- 3 **Toolkit for promoting young migrants skills**

Moreover:

- 50+ youth workers trained
- 40+ young migrants involved
- Increased competences, resilience and employability skills
